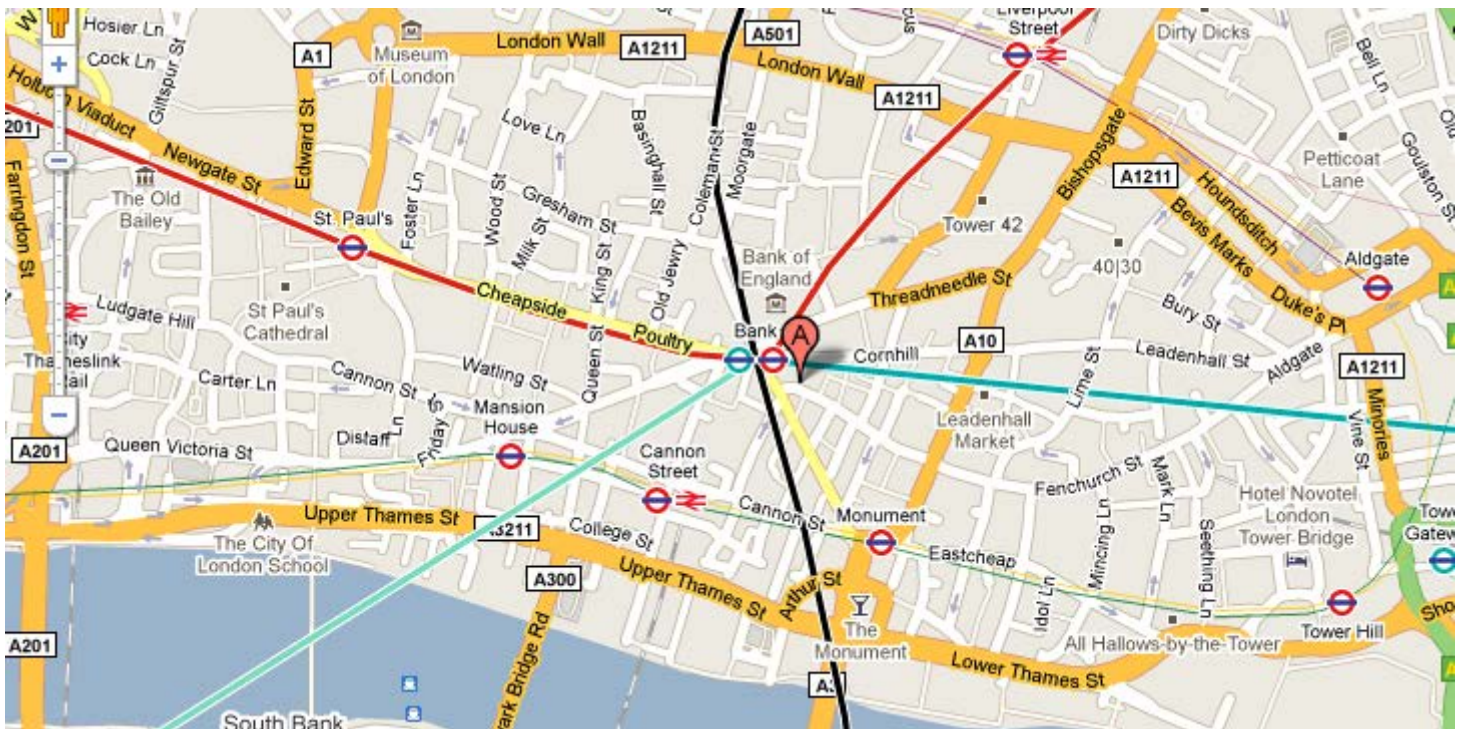


## The City

The city is the heart Greater London and is the core to the history of capital. Today The City is a major financial and business centre, with the same ranking as New York City as the leading global financial capital. The impressive area is also home to skyscrapers such as Bishopsgate Tower, Heron Tower, The Leadenhall Building and 20 Fenchurch Street.

## Transport






The City is serviced by 12 Underground tube stations including Bank and Monument, three Nation Rail stations including Liverpool Street and Fenchurch Street, two Thameslink mainline stations; Blackfriars and City Thameslink as well as having access to the A1, A3 and A4.

In 2017 a Crossrail railway line is scheduled to be completed, which will run underground across the north of the City that can be accessed through two stations located at Liverpool Street, which will be linked to Moorgate and Farringdon, which will be linked to Barbican.

The city also caters many [bus routes](#) that run throughout the day and night, with two bus stations located at Liverpool Street near the train station and Aldgate.

As well as on land transport links there are also river services provided in The City with the London River Services located on the City of London shore, where you will also find one of the Port of London safeguarded wharfs, Walbrook Wharf. There are also many piers such as Swan Lane Pier, which is to be extended within 2012 - 2015, Blackfriars Millennium Pier and Tower Pier.
