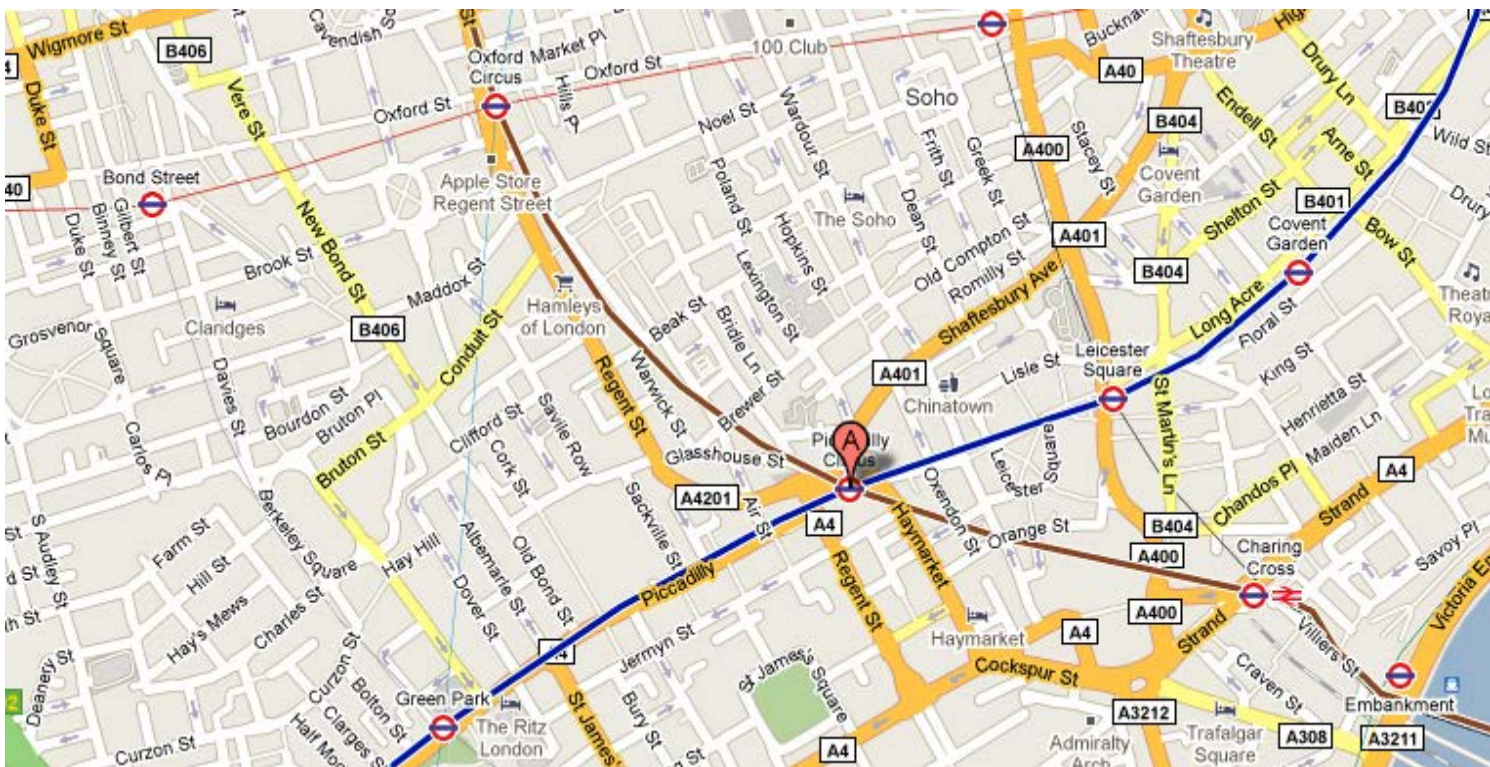


The West End

The West End is one of the most glamorous areas of Central London, the home to theatres, major tourist attractions, empires and the largest shopping district in Europe. There are many reasons to visit London's West End; shop around Oxford Street, walk along The Strand, or surround yourself with antiques on Charing Cross Road. The West End is served by several London underground lines with the main services being the Piccadilly line, Central line, Northern line, Bakerloo line and Victoria line. The most frequented stations in the area included Leicester Square, Piccadilly Circus, Oxford Street and Tottenham Court Road. There are also over land rail services available from Charing Cross station.
